Living Skies Come Alive will feature Canada vs U.S.

Sask Express, Stuck on Red, Shifty Morgan will all be performing over the weekend

Every August long weekend, the skies come alive over Moosomin Lake.

For the second year, the Living Skies Come Alive Fireworks Competition at Moosomin Regional Park on the August long weekend will be an international competition.

Traditionally, the fireworks competition has been between Saskatchewan and Manitoba, with a fireworks company from each province doing their best work and competing for bragging rights—one company setting off their fireworks on the Saturday night of the long weekend, and one setting theirs off on the Sunday night.

The fireworks are set off across from the main beach, so the fireworks are reflected in the lake.

The 2017 fireworks competition was different, however, with Canada taking on China in the first-ever international fireworks competition at Moosomin Lake.

This year the competition will be Canada versus the United States, and the competition will take place August 4 and 5.

CanFire Pyrotechnics of Winnipeg will compete for Canada and J&M Displays will compete for the United States. J&M

is one of the largest fireworks companies in the United States.

There will be entertainment by Sask Express both afternoons, then by Stuck on Red before and after the fireworks on Saturday, August 4, and by Shifty Morgan before and after the fireworks on Sunday, August 5.

The bands will start at 7:30 pm each night, will break for the fireworks, then will play one more set after the fireworks.

Layne McFarlane of the fireworks committee said he believes that adding Sask Express to the mix, and having the music continue after the fireworks, will add a lot to the weekend.

"Sask Express contacted us about being part of the weekend, and we are happy to have them," he said. "I think they will be a good addition to the weekend."

The weekend will include many events around the fireworks shows, and several food vendors will be set up at the park.

Advance tickets for the event are \$15 per person, and tickets at the gate are \$20 per person.

Last year's Living Skies Come Alive weekend attracted 12,500 people, making it the largest event in southeast Saskatchewan in 2017.

The 2017 event raised \$150,000 for Moosomin Regional Park.

Rocanville's Chase the Ace starts with a bang

Rocanville's Chase the Ace draw started on April 19, and already the lottery—which supports six community groups in town—is getting a great response from the community.
"It's working well so far. Both weeks Grid Iron was

packed and everyone is coming out for the draw. We thought it would be very slow at the start, but it just went," says Kari Lesmeister, who has helped organize the lottery.
Rocanville's Chase the Ace is a little different than others in a few ways. First, it supports six community

groups—golf course, play school, pool, playground, minor ball, and curling club. And secondly, people can buy tickets all week leading up to the event, and put the name of a proxy on their ticket who can draw their card if they can't be there.
Lesmeister says it got

started as a way to drum up some funds for the town's facilities.
"I joined the rec board as a member at large and I just thought it would be a great way to raise more funds as a community whole rather than all little groups doing different fundraisers all the time," she says. "I thought this could eliminate some of those and we could do one

large fundraiser.
"As a member of the rec board I brought it to their attention and it was kind of decided that chase the ace was such a time consuming event, so we formed our own subcommittee. I put the word out that this was available and was open to anyone, any group or facility in the town of Rocanville could join, and these are the

six that stepped up and said they would like to be a part of it. I formed a committee with one representative from each of those places. And then they have to be in charge and they have their committee to help them on their event."
The different groups take turns running the Chase the Ace.

 Each facility has to run the event every six weeks. So you don't have to commit every Thursday for the entire year," says Lesmeister. "Board members of the places can also sell tickets. It definitely made it a lot easier to get it going."
 "Every few months it was agreed that we would split the funds evenly to all the groups. It just kind of helps with some of the facilities who need the money sooner than others, instead of waiting until next year. So everyone gets an equal share."
 Lesmeister says the idea of having a proxy also helps with the pop-

ularity of the lottery.
 "If you are from out of town and you want to support these facilities, you can buy a ticket and write on the ticket a proxy. If you can not attend the event but your ticket is pulled, your proxy can cut the deck of cards for you."
 Tickets are available from Deckers H20, Grid Iron Bar and Grill, the golf course, or from any board member.
 The Chase the Ace goes every Thursday at the Grid Iron Bar and Grill, but will be moved to the Rocanville Golf clubhouse come summer. The draw runs from 5:30 to

7:30 pm, with ticket sales stopping round 7:25 pm and the draw being made at 7:30 pm each Thursday.
 Lesmeister said she had heard a lot of good things about Chase the Ace draws from other communities, which is why Rocanville decided to go ahead with one.
 "I heard great stories. Other towns and communities have done this fundraiser and raised tremendous amounts of money and I just thought it would be a great opportunity for Rocanville," she says. "We have a lot of facilities in our town that we would like to keep going."

Sheldon Kennedy bestowed with Courage Award from ACC

Former NHL hockey player Sheldon Kennedy is being presented with the second annual Courage Award by Assiniboine Community College.

"Since I came forward in 1996, my mission was simply to help others and make the future a safer place for our kids," Kennedy said. "To receive awards for this work is such an amazing honour and I am so grateful to receive the 2018 Assiniboine Courage Award. It is especially meaningful having this happen in my own backyard!"

The Courage Award was established by Assiniboine Community College in 2017 to commend and honour people who demonstrate courage in all its forms in their business, community, professional or personal life.

"We are honoured to have Sheldon Kennedy accept this award for the courage he demonstrated by coming forward about the sexual abuse he endured for years and for his continued advocacy work to prevent and treat child abuse across North America," ACC pres-

ident Mark Frison said.

Born in Brandon in 1969 and raised in Elkhorn, Kennedy found hockey a natural outlet for his youthful energy.

"We only had 150 people who lived in our town, so we'd go play hockey. It was a way of life," Kennedy recalls in Swift Current, the 2016 documentary about his life.

But the opportunity to play Major Junior hockey as a teenager turned sour when Kennedy was sexually abused by his coach, Graham James. He kept the secret locked inside for many years, fearing reprisals if he said anything.

Kennedy is now the Lead Director at the Sheldon Kennedy Child Advocacy Centre, the first of its kind in Canada, offering full services for victims of child abuse. He is also the Co-Founder of Respect Group, which provides education online to help prevent abuse, bullying and harassment.

During his professional hockey career, Kennedy was signed by four different National Hockey League

teams and their American Hockey League affiliates, including the Winnipeg Jets and the Manitoba Moose.

Kennedy's life has been the subject of a 1999 TV movie, The Sheldon Kennedy Story, his 2006 book, Why I Didn't Say Anything and Swift Current.

When Kennedy went public in 1996, his story inspired others to come forward, including NHL star Theo Fleury, who had been abused by the same coach. James was charged, convicted and sentenced to jail time in two separate trials, one for Kennedy and another player and the second one for Fleury and another player.

Kennedy will receive

the award at a dinner in his honour on Thursday, Oct. 25 at the Victoria Inn and Convention Centre in Brandon, MB. Tickets are available on the college website at assiniboine.net/courage.

The dinner will be co-chaired by Sheila North Wilson, Grand Chief of Manitoba Keewatinowik Okimakanak and Don Penny, founding partner and past chairman of MNP LLP (formerly Meyers Norris Penny), recipient of Assiniboine's first Courage Award in 2017.

Doug Wight fundraiser raises \$30,500

A benefit steak supper and silent auction for Wawota's Doug Wight on May 5 brought out a show of support of 260 people and raised \$30,500.

Doug has been battling pancreatic cancer and has been back and forth to Regina for chemo treatments and other procedures ever since.

He says he is extremely grateful for the support shown by the community.

"I was kind of overwhelmed that the community was coming together like that," he says.

"I live just up the hill from the hall, and when we walked down and came over the little crest in the hill and I saw all the cars I thought 'holy moly, wow look at all the vehicles!'

When I got to the hall we started to meet people, and then when I got into the hall it basically sat me down, I couldn't believe the people who were at the hall. It was amazing.

"How the people all come together to help one family, it was phenomenal. Sherry (Doug's wife) and I couldn't believe it. All my life I've been out in the community and done community stuff and my job and helping people with their problems, and then to turn around and see the people come and help you was just amazing."

Doug will have chemo treatments every two weeks for three months. He says the funds raised will really help with the expenses.

"It's going to lift a big weight off our shoulders," he says. "Just going back and forth, it doesn't matter what someone says, whether you are just going to Regina and back, it still costs money. Every time you go to Regina and come back and then your meal, it all adds up very quickly."

"The help is phenomenal and just seeing the community come together like that—I had a bit of a thank you when we were there. That was one thing I asked the audience, to stand up and applaud themselves, to give themselves a round of applause simply because it's great to see the com-

munity come together.

"It was just the thoughtfulness of people. There were people that I'd deal with through my job (Wight is a long-time employee of Pattison Ag) from Lampman and Arcola and Carlyle and in the Moosomin area and so on. There were people there from everywhere."

Murray Lucas was one of the people who helped organize the fundraiser. Murray works with Doug at Pattison Ag in Moosomin.

"It was amazing the support they got from the locals in Wawota, everybody was there from town," he says. "It was very much appreciated that they came out, and they supported it bigtime. Everybody was willing to bid on some of the live auction stuff we had, and we had several 50/50 draws, and we had some draws for a pressure washer we had donated. It was great participation for everybody and nobody said no, everybody just kept buying tickets and kept the money rolling."

"Doug has been a long term employee at Pattison, 25-30 years he's been employed, he's a great guy and everyone here has worked with him for years and years, and it was just the natural thing to do, to try to help him out."

Cindy Blondeau fundraiser raises \$19,887

When Alma Ducharme set out to help Cindy Blondeau, who has been battling cancer since 2012, she was hoping that a fundraiser held on Saturday, April 28 in Moosomin would raise around \$10,000. Instead, the fundraiser far exceeded her expectations, with all 200 tickets selling out, bringing in \$19,887.

"It was absolutely perfect, it couldn't have been better," said Ducharme last week.

"It couldn't have been any better than it was. We sold out at 200 tickets. We were allowed 200 in the hall, and we sold them all out. It was really, really great."

"I was hoping for \$10,000. I said I'll be happy if we make \$10,000, but just the silent auction alone brought in over \$7,000. It was absolutely great."

The fundraiser consisted of a supper, dance and silent auction. Ducharme says a bunch of people pitched in to help her organize it.

"I'm not the only one. There is no way I could do that alone," she says. "It made me feel so good that everyone helped out. It makes me really happy that there's such nice people out there. I couldn't have done it without them."

Cindy Blondeau has been battling cancer since 2012 when it was detected in a routine mammogram. The cancer was advanced at the time it was detected, and has since spread to her spine, pelvis and ribs.

The fundraiser will be to help the Blondeaus cover the cost of travel, accommodation, meals and medical expenses. Cindy has been getting treatment at the Allan Blair Cancer Centre in Regina, and one of her treatments, which will no longer be covered by Saskatchewan Medicare, will cost her \$1,200 a month.

Cindy was able to attend the fundraiser on April 28 and says she is "incredibly humbled and grateful" to the people who came out to support her. She says, as well as local people, family members from around the

country came to Moosomin for the fundraiser.

"When Alma and her husband had first come to visit me and said that she wanted to do it, I tried to talk her out of it," she says. "I told her she did not need to take that on, she had enough going on in her life but she was determined. I tried to give in as graciously as I could and thanked her and told her that would be wonderful and I would try and help, and she said 'nope, I have it all taken care of.' She is an organizational wizard."

"I was incredibly humbled and grateful and just really appreciated the support. It was a really emotional evening. Some people came from a long distance away to be there with us. It is overwhelming and heartwarming, and exactly what I needed."

Cindy says the show of support is just as important as the money raised.

"I know that was really important for Eddie (her husband), too, to see so many of the family and friends, to see them all come together like that," she says. "There is a huge mental toll that's taken when you diagnosed with a terminal disease. The support is every bit as important as the financial part of it."

Cindy says the financial support will be a big help.

"I do a lot of trips to Regina by myself and we do a lot together when I have to go up for radiation for pain control," she says. "I usually stay there instead of going back and forth and there is always expenses to it, and the drug that I'm on right now is covered by the Saskatchewan Drug Formulary, and when it stops working the next one they would like to put me on is not covered. It was and now it's not, it is under review. It would run roughly \$1,200 a month. There are a couple more that are available now that are possibilities—it depends on where the cancer progresses to, and a couple more of them are not covered."

"Even though we live in Saskatchewan and in Canada, there is a lot of

financial toll with some of the drugs."

Cindy says she has a long journey ahead of her, but right now she is feeling well.

"I'm doing well. I was diagnosed back in 2012, and it has been a long time with a stage four," she says. "The first drug they put me on lasted for five and half years but then the cancer progressed last fall. It's still in my bones, it hasn't got into any of my organs yet, but it did move into more bones and some of them grew significantly, and that's why I was in more pain. That's how come we knew something was happening and went in and had that radiated and moved on to another drug, and I've had one set of scans since then and the doctor thinks it's working but he won't be really confident in it until we do the scans in July. That is how my life goes—three months at a time."

Cindy says her cancer was too advanced for standard chemo.

"Once I was diagnosed and had all of the scans done it had already spread. I was basically stage four from the beginning, so there was no point doing those treatments, those are meant to stop it from coming back, so I was out the gate already. The radiation I've had is just for pain control, it's targeted to certain tumors to kill them so they don't kill the nerves."

Cindy says her life is dictated by cancer now.

"It completely runs it," she says. "Day to day I'm still functioning fairly well. I was doing much better a couple years ago before it progressed, but now my mobility is effected. I don't walk like I used to because now pain is more of an issue."

She says she is blessed to have people like Alma who care about her.

"We are so blessed to have Alma in our lives," she says. "The friends, family, community and support we've gotten has really been heartwarming and means a lot to us. Alma was amazing. She just went to work and put the word out and everybody fell into line."



How to paint metal



Have a metal surface to paint? Follow these steps to get the best results.

First off, get rid of any traces of rust. To do this you can use a steel brush, an emery board or a file. If unsightly welds are revealed in the process, sand them down until the metal is smooth. Certain household chemicals and products, such as phosphorus and oven cleaners, are also useful for getting rid of rust.

Next, clean the metal using a damp sponge, and then dry the surface with a clean cloth. As soon as you're done cleaning — don't wait too long, as bare metal is quick to rust — apply a coat of primer designed for metal and compatible with the paint you'll be using. Once the base coat is dry (refer to the manu-

facturer's instructions for drying time), apply as many coats of paint as necessary. You can use a regular paintbrush, but spraying the paint on (either with a spray gun or a can of spray paint) will prevent visible brush strokes.

Glossy paint dries more slowly than other finishes and makes fingerprints quite noticeable.



Four easy-to-grow outdoor plants

Are you a gardening novice looking for some easy-to-grow plant varieties to get started with? Here are a few foolproof options for you to try this summer.

1. Marigolds
 Deep golden yellow marigolds grow easily and require little maintenance: all you'll need to do is remove wilted flowers as they appear and water when the weather gets really hot. Their pungent smell acts as a natural repellent against aphids, among other pests.

How to remove stains from leather furniture

Did your kids scribble all over your leather sofas with markers? Has the blue dye from your new pair of jeans bled onto your couch? Did someone spill a glass of red wine on your favourite armchair? Don't panic! There are several ways to remove stains from leather furniture.

First and foremost, it's important to note that most non-greasy stains easily disappear when lightly dabbed at with a moist cloth. Act quickly and make sure to use a light-coloured fabric to clean with — certain colours bleed, which would only make things worse.

Still seeing the stain? Trade in your cloth for a cotton ball dipped in makeup remover and lightly dab that pesky spot. If you're trying to get rid of an alcohol or a soot stain, add a few drops of vinegar to your cotton ball. As for coffee, tea, dye and ink, a drop of rubbing alcohol should do the trick.

COMMON MISTAKES TO AVOID

Leather reacts poorly to moisture. For this reason, don't let it get too wet during the stain removal process, and make sure to dry the surface thoroughly with a clean cloth after you've dealt with the stain. It's also important to avoid scrubbing at all costs, opting instead for a delicate dabbing technique. Lastly, always spot test stain removal products on

a non-visible area before using them to avoid accidental damage.

When in doubt, call upon a professional cleaner who'll know how to remove even the most stubborn of stains from your leather furniture. What's more, you can always contact the manufacturer for personalized cleaning advice.

Interview with Conservative Leader Andrew Scheer:

Scheer says new approach to pipelines needed

On Thursday, April 19, World-Spectator editor Kevin Weedmark spoke with federal Conservative leader Andrew Scheer about the problem of getting pipelines built in Canada.

Following is a complete transcript of the interview portion of the conversation:

The CEO of Kinder Morgan is now saying that the uncertainty around TransMountain is making the project untenable. How should this whole file have

been handled?

We need to go back and look at where this all started.

Justin Trudeau put out this false narrative in the last election that the approval process was to blame. He started undermining the credibility of our independent, science-based approval process that saw four major pipelines built during the Conservative government.

He emboldened protestors by saying

that everyone had to grant social license, and that only communities could grant permission, which really did fuel up all those groups that are perennially opposed to any type of development.

Then he killed Northern Gateway based on political considerations. They are not based on science, they're not based on legitimate environmental concerns, they are just based on a political promise during the campaign.

He is putting in a carbon tax and threat-

ening the energy industry with some of the most outrageous regulations in bill C69.

That is why we are where we are today. With TransMountain—the stakes are so high with TransMountain. It's getting all the attention. It's where all the protestors tend to converge on, because it is the only pipeline in the works right now.

He killed Northern Gateway and he killed Energy East.

So after lack of action for months, Justin Trudeau only just last week met with Premier Horgan of B.C. Conservatives have been calling on Justin Trudeau to meet with Premier Horgan to start working on an off-ramp from this confrontation. We've been asking for months. We had a motion from the House of Commons in February. The Liberals voted against it. So we are where we are today because of Justin Trudeau's complete mismanagement of the energy file.

What side do you think the Prime Minister is on on this particular project?

I suspect when you look at everything that he has ever said, when you look at Gerald Butts, the man running government in Ottawa right now, they don't believe in the energy sector, they want to phase out the oil sands.

I think Justin Trudeau is happy to let others do his dirty work and I have no doubt that he would be very happy to watch this pipeline get cancelled or delayed to the point where Kinder Morgan just has to back off themselves.

What does the federal government need to do now to ensure that the Trans Mountain project can proceed?

It is so late now that anything they do will take time.

They need to clearly stand up for federal areas of jurisdiction. This was declared to be of national interest some time ago.

They should have spelled out a legal framework about what that meant months ago. They need to reappear Bill C69.

Bill C69 is not getting the attention it deserves but when you talk to literally everyone involved in the energy sector, whether it's drillers and extractors to pipeline manufacturers to primary producers to heavy trades, they realize that bill C69 will make it so that there is not another major energy project ever again in this country.

They need to restore some confidence in the sector so that companies do have patience to deal with some legal challenges or with some minor delays.

Right now there is all that conflict and the federal government has to be a champion for them. That is just so incredibly important.

I know the Liberals would like us to focus on Kinder Morgan, they would like this to be the criteria of whether or not they are successful or not, but this should not be about TransMountain, this should be about Energy East, Northern Gateway, this should be about everything.

They drove out \$87 billion dollars of investment into the energy sector. What Justin Trudeau is now saying is in order to get a pipeline built in Canada you need to have the federal government use taxpayer dollars to get it built, basically nationalizing parts of the energy sector. That is a terrible indictment of his own record.

I don't know how familiar you are with Moosomin—you were here during the leadership campaign—but we have the TransCanada Pipeline just to the north of us and the Enbridge Pipeline just to the south, and Moosomin is often a field office site for pipeline construction on both lines. With the cancellation of Energy East we lost what would have been a massive tank farm at the Moosomin Compressor Station, and feeder pipelines from Cromer, Manitoba and Williston, North Dakota to the Moosomin site. TransCanada of course cancelled the project after changes in the federal approval process. Can you foresee any way in which a project like that could

be resurrected under a new regulatory regime?

I would make it a priority as Prime Minister to try to get TransCanada back to the table.

There is still a market in eastern Canada for western energy.

I don't believe that motorists in Quebec or Ontario or Atlantic Canada are happy that they are importing oil from other countries.

There are tankers full of oil coming up the St. Lawrence into eastern refineries.

They killed the project because, as you mentioned, the Trudeau Liberals changed the regulatory process to include both upstream and downstream emissions.

It's the only sector of our economy that is now subject to that complete double standard and a standard that is not applied to oil being imported.

I believe that by removing those conditions and by repealing C69 we could show the investors and companies that you have a government that is going to be a champion of the sector, and hopefully they would come back to the table, so I do think that is possible.

Energy East was one of those grand nation building projects that would have brought our country closer together.

It had support in Atlantic Canada, support in Quebec and Ontario outside of the political realm. Many people in the economy outside of government knew that would be great for the economy, and I think that we could create the conditions for a win on that in a Conservative government and not with the Trudeau liberal government.

With the Enbridge Line 3 replacement, we just had five officials from Enbridge come out yesterday to the Moosomin Chamber of Commerce. We were told yesterday the company still isn't totally ready to let out contracts on the Saskatchewan spreads—although they're hoping to have more clarity within a few weeks.

That's a project that has met all the approvals in Canada and is now facing uncertainty because of opposition in Minnesota.

Looking at all these pipeline projects, do we need a whole new approach to pipeline approvals so there is some certainty?

We need to stop having different levels of government act embarrassed about it.

Pipelines are safe, they're environmentally friendly, they move energy with minimal greenhouse gas emissions—better than trains and trucks.

We should be proud of it.

We should be proud of the fact that we have ethically extracted environmentally sustainable energy coming out of west-

ern Canada.

It's extracted the cleanest way in the world.

We should be creating a brand for Canada for Canadian energy. That, I think, would help allay some of the concerns that others have in other areas—protesters and opponents who never support any new development in the energy sector play off of it. I think that is critical. We need a better established legal framework to ensure that once the objective criteria are met for these projects, that every level of government respect that and allow it to proceed.

Scotiabank recently came out with a report on the impact of lack of pipeline access on the Canadian economy. Were you surprised to see the extent of the impact unveiled in that report.

No, we've known, we've been warning people about this for months now that the energy sector is a huge part of our country's economy, and lack of capacity to transport energy means stagnation.

It means there won't be new exploration.

Companies won't invest in finding new sources or production if they can't move their products.

That is true for any industry.

It impacts the agriculture sector when we can't move our grain because of backlogs on rail.

It's true with manufacturing when you can't get contracts for trucking, so it's no surprise that lack of market access and capacity of pipelines is have an effect on the overall economy.

In addition, we continue to take a massive discount on our energy because we are so dependent on one major customer, and the discount that we are taking from the U.S. market versus what we could get on the world market is a massive amount of lost potential in our economy that I'm not convinced Canadians everywhere realize how significant that is.

How important is it to reduce that differential between Western Canada Select and world prices for oil?

It is critical. I mean, to put it into personal terms, if you're selling anything, you wouldn't want to sell it at a discount to what you could be getting.

Farmers don't want to sell their grain at half of what they could get.

People who manufacture anything want to get the best possible price so they can hire more people, pay better wages and put more people back to work.

It is also subsidizing the American energy consumer by providing them with cheaper energy than they could get on the world market.

It's just not fair. It's a lost source of reve-

nue for provincial and federal governments to pay for things like health care and hospitals, schools and roads.

Is expanding pipeline capacity the only part of the puzzle, or are there other elements of government policy that would have to change to ensure that Canadian energy producers can get their products to market?

I mentioned C69 and I also believe the carbon tax has to go. Even the threat of the carbon tax coming in has had an impact around boardroom tables around the world.

We see companies moving investments out of Canada. They are not getting out of the energy business, but they are getting out of the energy business in Canada, and that started really once Justin Trudeau confirmed that he is going to impose a carbon tax on Canadians.

How different would a Conservative government's approach to pipelines be?

We are going to be coming out with more specifics on exactly what the regime would look like, but it is essential that we remember that under the previous government four major pipelines were constructed and a fifth, the Northern Gateway, was approved. The Liberals killed that.

There were some things that could have been done to streamline the process, getting some of the social issues, whether it's First Nations engagement or concerns around impacts on communities, out of the science-based aspect of the system, keeping the NEB looking more to the technical requirements and certainly the environmental impact, that type of thing.

A Conservative government would be that champion industry needs to create that Canadian brand that people around the world would want.

When you look at the work conditions in Saudi Arabia or Nigeria, when you look at the environmental standards and look at human rights concerns, we should want people in Europe, Asia, and South America clamoring for Canadian oil.

But when you have politicians like Justin Trudeau or the NDP over the course of the last decade running down our energy sector, running down the oil sands, running down Canadian companies that have a great record, it's no surprise that we have work to do to repair that.

If I can ask you one question on a totally different subject, there has been an outpouring of support for Humboldt across the country. Here in Moosomin on Friday night, Mike Schwan and a few people organized a junior game with about 100 current and former junior players that raised \$55,000 for Humboldt. What are your thoughts on seeing the response to the Humboldt Broncos tragedy across the country?

In the wake of an unimaginable tragedy, it is heart warming to see not just the province of Saskatchewan come together to support the families of the victims, but indeed the entire country.

Looking at what hockey teams in literally every province have done, or fundraisers that are going on all over the country, the outpouring of support internationally, Her Majesty the Queen, President Trump, foreign heads of state, I think the world really felt Humboldt's pain and I think that is very meaningful not just to the victims and their families but also to everyone in Saskatchewan who really do feel that this struck all of us on a personal level.

Sask's average farmland values continue to climb

Saskatchewan's average farmland values continued to climb at roughly the same rate as the Canadian average in 2017, a sign of a strong and stable agricultural economy, according to J.P. Gervais, chief agricultural economist for Farm Credit Canada (FCC).

The average value of Canadian farmland increased 8.4 per cent in 2017, following a gain of 7.9 per cent in 2016. Although average farmland values have increased every year since 1993, recent increases are less pronounced than the 2011-2015 period that recorded significant average farmland value increases in many different regions.

"With the steady climb of farmland values, now is a good time for producers to review and adjust their business plan to reflect variable commodity prices and slightly higher interest rates, assess their overall financial position and focus on increasing productivity," Gervais said. "It's also a good idea to have a risk management plan in place to protect your business against unforeseen circumstances and events."

In Saskatchewan, average farmland values increased by 10.2 per cent in 2017, following gains of 7.5 per cent in 2016 and 9.4 per cent in 2015. This was the largest average increase in farmland values reported among all provinces.

While Saskatchewan, Ontario and Nova Scotia reported the largest average increases, four provinces—British Columbia, Alberta, Manitoba and Prince Edward Island—saw a smaller increase from the previous year.

Quebec and New Brunswick both showed increases that were fairly close to the national average, while Newfoundland and Labrador didn't have enough transactions to fully assess farmland values in that province.

Some of last year's av-

erage farmland value increase may also be a result of timing as most provinces recorded a faster pace of increase in the first six months of the year while interest rate increases didn't occur until the latter half of 2017. Recent increases in borrowing costs and expectations of further increases could cool the farmland market in 2018, according to Gervais.

FCC's Farmland Values Report highlights average changes in farmland values—regionally, provincially and nationally. This year's report describes changes from January 1 to December 31, 2017 and, for the first time, provides

a value range in terms of price per acre.

"It's important to remember that farmland prices can vary widely within regions due to many local factors that can influence how much value a buyer and seller attach to a parcel of land," Gervais said.

He also stressed that every farm operation is unique and there may be a strong business case for buying more land, but not without carefully weighing the risks and rewards.

"Farm operations need to be cautious in regions where the growth rate of farmland values has exceeded that of farm incomes in recent

years," Gervais said.

"The good news is Canadian farms are generally in a strong financial position when it comes to net cash income and their balance sheets," he said.


Rance Cardinal reaches Saskatchewan

Rance Cardinal arrived in Saskatchewan Thursday, May 10 on his walk from northwest Ontario to Humboldt in honor of the Humboldt Broncos.

"It's not every day I'm able to go to a Jets game. It's maybe once a year. I had my sign saying 'I just want to be on TV. Minutes before we saw the breaking news on the TV,'" he says.

"It was just like a shockwave of pain that hit me. I have to tell you I never felt that since I lost my brother and my late teammate. So I changed my sign to Humboldt Strong, and it made the jumbotron. After the game I thought this would be such a huge honor to take that sign to Humboldt. After the game, I asked my uncle, what would you do if I walked to Humboldt. He gave me a different look. It wasn't a look of doubt, it was

more a look of pride. He said 'I'll support you the whole way.'

"From April 7 to April 11 I only got five hours of sleep. I was just thinking about it and talking about it. April 11 is when I started

walking."

Rance said it felt great to make it to Saskatchewan on Thursday evening. "It's a big ape off my back. To get here is just awesome. I get to start my healing process

a little more in depth. Each day I'm in Saskatchewan I'll be thinking of one of the people who died on that bus. I can't tell you how much I feel.

"The support is just unbelievable. Being told you're an inspiration. Being told you're a hero, being told you're bringing Canada together. It's something I would never ever think I would hear.

"I started off the day with the junior high kids at Virden and that was great way to start the day.

"Being told the kids were waiting for us at Elkhorn, it was exciting. When I got there it was unbelievable. Elkhorn is a small town with a really big heart."

"I want to develop my inner peace, strength and honor. So I'm learning how big a heart Canadians have. People are reaching out to me."

Rance lost a teammate to a car

accident, and knows how it feels to lose someone close. He also lost his younger brother to an illness in 2013.

"This is a time of healing, like my late brother would always say, we'll always bounce back. I want to send that message," he says. "We'll bounce back. This tragedy should say to everybody around the world our life is short our life is precious so live every moment like it's your last.

"What I've learned about myself is you just have to put your mind to whatever you're doing. You have to put your heart into it. I love hockey just as much as these boys did. It makes me sad, it hurts me to think about them. They were just young kids, young men.

"What I learned is you can't just live life too fast. You have to take time to enjoy the life you have."
